City Beverage Group Development -- CUP Amendment

Description

Mr. J. T. Dixon has applied for an amendment to CUP 5-2012 to construct two additional storage facilities at 1099 Driftwood Drive on Roanoke Island. There are two existing storage buildings at the property that were previously approved by Dare County. The site is zoned I-1 (industrial). The location of more than one principal use structure on the property constitutes a group development subject to review and approval by the Planning Board and Board of Commissioners. A staff report, draft CUP amendment and site plan are included with this cover sheet.

STAFF REPORT: City Beverage Warehouses-- Amendment to CUP 5-2012

DATE: January 3, 3017 Board of Commissioners Meeting

Mr. J. T. Dixon has submitted a revised site plan and CUP amendment application to amend CUP 5-2012. He plans to construct two additional storage warehouses at 1099 Driftwood Drive. There are currently two other warehouses on the site. The location of more than one principal use structure on the property constitutes a group development under section 22-31 of the Dare County Zoning Ordinance. Group developments are subject to conditional use review and approval by the Planning Board and Board of Commissioners. The site is zone 1-I industrial.

The two new buildings will be constructed in phases as noted on the site plan. The first building will consist of 19,800 square feet and the second building will consist of 2,500 square feet. Access and parking improvements shall be constructed as shown on the site plan. The proposed buildings will be used for storage only and will not be used for retail or office space. A condition to this effect is included in the CUP amendment.

The site is within the Manteo airport zoning overlay district. A copy of the site plan has been provided to the Dare County Airport Authority for review and approval.

Condition # 2 of the CUP amendment provides three years to the securing of a Dare County building permit. A copy of the draft CUP amendment and a copy of the original CUP 5-2012 is included with this staff report.

The Planning Board reviewed this CUP amendment request on December 12, 2016 and voted to recommend approval of the revised site plan and CUP amendment subject to approval of the request by the Dare County Airport Authority.

The State stormwater permit and sedimentation control permit will be modified for the construction of the additional improvements.



AMENDMENT to CUP No. 5-2012

Dare County Sections 22-27, 22-31 and 22-68.

Application of: J.T. Dixon Sr. for City Beverage Company

On January 3, 2017 the Dare County Board of Commissioners considered an amendment to CUP 5-2012 issued to J.T. Dixon Sr for the City Beverage group development on Roanoke Island. The original CUP was issued in February 2013 by the Dare County Board of Commissioners for the construction of a 10,800 square foot storage building. This amendment is for the construction of two additional mini storage warehouses.

On December 12, 2016 the Dare County Planning Board reviewed the proposed amendment and recommended approval of the amendment.

The following conditions shall be added to the original conditional use permit authorized by Dare County:

- 1. Two additional mini storage warehouses shall be constructed with associated site improvements. One building shall consist of 19,800 square feet and the second building shall consist of 2,500square feet.
- 2. A Dare County building permit for the first phase shall be secured within three (3) years of the date of approval of this CUP amendment.
- 3. The building shall be used for storage. The buildings shall not be used for residential, retail, office or other commercial uses. Approval from the Dare County Airport Authority shall be secured before a building permit can be issued. An as-built site plan shall be submitted to Dare County at completion of each of the proposed structures.
- 4. Additional lighting fixtures shall be installed similar to existing fixtures on site.
- 5. All fencing new and existing shall be compliant with Dare County Code and prior conditions set forth in CUP 5-2012
- 6. All other terms and conditions as set forth in CUP 5-2012 remain in effect.

Conditional Use Permit No. 5-2012

Dare County Sections 22-27, 22-31 and 22-68.

Application of: Jay Dixon Sr. for City Beverage Company

On February 4, 2013 the Dare County Board of Commissioners considered the application of the Petitioner above named which application is on file with the Dare County Planning Department, and the Board finds as follows:

- 1. That the written application of Petitioner with attachments has been duly submitted to the Dare County Planning Board as required by Section 22 of the Dare County Code (hereinafter referred to as "Code");
- 2. That the application substantially complies with the requirements of the Code in that it requests uses permitted by conditional use permit under the Code, including family housing complexes;
- 3. That the Petitioner owns 4.67 acres located at which is identified on the Dare County Tax Records as Parcel No. 025252000. The property is zoned I-1 industrial and group developments are permitted in the district as conditional uses;
- 4. That the Dare County Planning Board recommended for approval the granting of this Conditional Use Permit as requested. The Planning Board made this recommendation on December 10, 2012.
- 5. That the Dare County Board of Commissioners is empowered under sections of the Code set out above to grant uses such as allowed herein and insofar as the conditional use is hereinafter allowed it will not adversely affect the public interest;
- 6. That the hereinafter described conditional use is deemed to be reasonable and is not in degradation of the intent of the ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, under the provisions of the Code, the following conditional use is granted to City Beverage Company for a group development subject to such conditions as are hereinafter set out:

CONDITIONAL USE: a group development consisting of two storage warehouses as depicted on the site plan identified as Appendix B and made a part of this conditional use permit.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. There is an existing 15,277 square foot storage facility on the site that was constructed in 2004. A 10,800 square foot second building is proposed for construction as part of this group development permit. The units shall be used for unconditioned storage and no storage unit shall be used or occupied for residential or commercial purposes.
- 2. A building permit for construction of the proposed 10,800 square foot storage building shall be secured from Dare County within twelve months of the date of CUP approval by the Board of Commissioners. An as-built survey of the site shall be submitted to the Planning Department prior to issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy for the new storage building.
- 3. The existing chainlink fencing on the site shall be modified to feature slatting in the fence in those sections of the fence that abut the residential uses as depicted on Appendix B. The applicant shall be responsible for the maintenance of the fencing.
- 4. Parking for the individual storage units shall be allowed immediately adjacent to the storage buildings to facilitate the loading and unloading of any individual units.
- 5. Parking of RVs, boats shall be permitted in those areas as noted on Appendix B.
- 6. Additional lighting fixtures shall be installed that are similar to the existing fixtures on the site. The new light fixtures shall be installed so that no light illuminates or reflects on any adjacent property or public right-of-way.
- 7. Tenants of the storage buildings shall be allowed access to the site between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. daily.
- 8. State permits for stormwater management and soil erosion and sedimentation control shall be secured prior to the issuance of any Dare County building permit. Copies of the State permits shall be submitted with the building permit application and building plans.
- 9. The Planning Department staff shall monitor the site. The applicant shall be notified in writing of any violation of this CUP. Appropriate measures to correct any violation identified by the Dare County Planning Department shall be made upon receipt of notice. Failure to correct any violations may void this CUP and may result in the assessment of civil penalties as provided for in Chapter 10 of the Dare County Code of Ordinance and/or any other legal remedy available to Dare County.
- 10. A copy of the site plan shall be provided to the Dare County Airport Authority to review the proposed location of the second storage building to ensure there are no conflicts with the airport overlay district. If any conflicts are identified by the DCAA, then revisions shall be

made to the site plan as needed to ensure compliance with the regulations of the airport overlay district.

11. It is understood that all other terms and provisions of the Code shall remain in full force and effect except as herein lawfully permitted;





Resolution Opposing a Petition to Designate Special Secondary Nursery Areas

Description

The NC Wildlife Federation has submitted a petition for rulemaking with the Marine Fisheries Commission that seeks to designate all inshore and ocean waters out to three miles as Special Secondary Nursery Areas. If approved, this would have a devastating impact on commercial fishing families and seafood consumers.

At the December 19, 2016 Board of Commissioners meeting Commissioner Steve House asked people to submit public comments and called on the Board to adopt a resolution opposing the petition for rulemaking.

Attached is a resolution urging the North Carolina Marine Fisheries Commission to reject the petition.

RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE DESIGNATION OF SPECIAL SECONDARY NURSERY AREAS

WHEREAS, a petition for rulemaking to designate Special Secondary Nursery Areas and Reduce Bycatch Mortality has been submitted to the NC Marine Fisheries Commission by the NC Wildlife Federation; and

WHEREAS, the petition seeks to designate all inshore and ocean waters out to three miles as Special Secondary Nursery Areas and define the type of gear and how and when gear may be used during shrimp season; and

WHEREAS, if adopted, the petition would severely limiting shrimp trawling, which would have a devastating impact on commercial fishing families by arbitrarily impairing their livelihood and depriving American tables of fresh, healthy catches of North Carolina harvested shrimp; and

WHEREAS, shrimp trawling has been a vibrant and successful part of North Carolina's heritage and culture for all of its history and represents a means by which generations of commercial watermen create jobs, provide for their families, and contribute to the economic wellbeing of North Carolina's coastal communities; and

WHEREAS, existing state and federal regulations provide ample provisions for monitoring and regulation of commercial shrimping with serious penalties and sanctions for rule violations, which have proven to be effective in preventing overfishing and waste; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Dare County Board of Commissioners hereby opposes the petition for rulemaking to Designate Special Secondary Nursery Areas and Reduce Bycatch Mortality In North Carolina Coastal Fishing Waters as set forth by the NC Wildlife Federation and strongly urges the North Carolina Marine Fisheries Commission to reject it.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dare County Board of Commissioners asks all coastal communities to support North Carolina's working watermen by adopting similar resolutions in opposition of this petition for rulemaking that would put North Carolina shrimping in jeopardy.

MINUTES DARE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

Dare County Administration Building, Manteo, NC

A full and complete account of the entire Board of Commissioners meeting is archived on a video that is available for viewing on the Dare County website www.darenc.com.

Chairman Woodard called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m. He invited the Rev. Lorrie Ghering-Burick from Roanoke Island Presbyterian Church to share a prayer, and then he led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Note – In order to accommodate the Public Hearing scheduled for 5:30 p.m., some agenda items were handled out of sequential order.

ITEM 1 - OPENING REMARKS - CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE

Chairman Woodard mentioned the following items during his opening remarks –

- Reported on a farewell reception honoring Dr. Kandi Deitemeyer who is leaving COA to take another community college position.
- Commented on beach erosion issues in the Village of Avon.
- Thanked Commissioner Couch for spearheading Commissioner participation in the Hatteras Christmas Parade.
- Noted that a letter has been sent to Colonel Grey at the North Carolina Highway Patrol requesting traffic control assistance during summer weekends.
- Thanked the economic development consultants for a report on the economic diversification plan that was given earlier today at a special meeting. He said the Board will be discussing the comprehensive report in the coming weeks.
- Read a letter that was sent to Governor McCrory thanking him for his service.
- Commended Governor McCrory and the North Carolina Legislature for the recently approved package of relief for Hurricane Matthew recovery.
- Provided an update report on debris removal related to Hurricane Matthew.
- Commented on the recent Celebration of Flight at the Wright Brothers Memorial.

- The Chairman asked NCDOT Board Member Malcolm Fearing to give an update on the status of the bridge planned for Rodanthe. Mr. Fearing provided information about the Rodanthe project and read a resolution adopted by the NCDOT Transportation Board concerning local expansion of the Blue Star Memorial Highway to honor Veterans.
- In a surprise presentation, Chairman Woodard, joined by Steve Keen from Governor McCrory's office, presented the Order of the Long Leaf Pine to Malcolm Fearing in recognition of his integrity, vision, compassion, and extraordinary public service.

ITEM 2 - PUBLIC COMMENTS

The Manager outlined the procedure for making public comments in Manteo and via the video link to the Fessenden Center in Buxton. Citizen remarks can be seen in their entirety on the county website www.darenc.com. Following is a brief summary –

The following Public Comments were made in Manteo –

 Pat Weston commented on beach erosion issues plaguing Avon. She thanked National Park Service Superintendent David Hallac and Frank Jennings with CAMA for their cooperation in addressing a 225-foot breach that occurred due to Hurricane Matthew. She also identified an area that has experienced severe erosion since then. Ms. Weston called on the Board for help saying that beach nourishment is needed sooner rather than later. She explained that this problem impacts all of Hatteras Island and threatens to jeopardize tourism and our economy.

There were no Public Comments via the video link to the Fessenden Center in Buxton.

ITEM 3 - PRESENTATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2016 CAFR AND AUDIT RESULTS

Finance Director David Clawson along with Bob Taylor from Potter & Company presented the fiscal year 2016 audit results and Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR). Mr. Taylor said his auditing firm was giving an opinion without any qualifications or exceptions noted, which he said is good news. Mr. Clawson gave the Board a detailed summary of the CAFR component units and funds and highlighted changes in revenues and expenditures. He noted improvement in the Insurance Fund balance deficit and said the General Fund balance level increased by \$2,167,003. ITEM 4 – PUBLIC HEARING – PROPOSED C-2 TEXT AMENDMENT TO ADD INDOOR RECREATION USES

At 5:43 p.m., the Dare County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing to receive input concerning this agenda item. The County Manager conducted the hearing and explained the procedure for making comments. No one responded to the invitation to address the Board. Chairman Woodard closed the hearing at 5:43 p.m. Planning Director, Donna Creef summarized the proposed text amendment that would allow indoor recreation uses in the C-2 district encompassing Avon and Buxton.

MOTION

Commissioner Shea motioned to amend the C-2 zoning district to add indoor recreation uses to the list of permitted uses in this district as recommended by the Planning Board with the finding that this amendment is consistent with the policies of the 2009 Land Use Plan and other official documents specifically policy LUC #5 which encourages the continued existence of locally owned businesses.

Commissioner Boswell seconded the motion.

VOTE: AYES unanimous

ITEM 5 - CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner House seconded the motion.

ITEM 6 - COMMISSIONERS' BUSINESS & MANAGER'S/ATTORNEY'S BUSINESS

Following is a brief outline of items raised during this segment. Commissioners and the County Manager frequently make extensive remarks, which can be viewed in their entirety on a video archived on the Dare County website www.darenc.com.

<u>Commissioner Boswell</u> – expressed thanks for the work of Malcolm Fearing on the NCDOT Transportation Board and congratulated him on receiving the Order of the Long Leaf Pine from Governor McCrory. Commissioner Boswell noted that the conditions at Oregon Inlet look good now and she wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

<u>Commissioner House</u> – extended Christmas greetings and urged people to be safe and remember emergency service personnel who are away from their families during the holiday. Commissioner House provided details about how people can submit public comments in opposition to the petition for rulemaking that has been submitted to the North Carolina Marine Fisheries Commission. The petition, if approved, would create Special Secondary Nursery Areas, which would have a harmful effect on watermen. He asked the Board to consider a resolution opposing the rulemaking petition.

MOTION

Commissioner House motioned to approve drafting a resolution that will be brought back to the Board at its next meeting

Commissioners Boswell, Shea, Overman, and Couch seconded the motion.

VOTE: AYES unanimous

<u>Vice-Chairman Overman</u> – congratulated Malcolm Fearing on being awarded the Order of the Long Leaf Pine. He provided an update on Hatteras Inlet and said the permitting effort is moving in the right direction. He wished everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year with peace on earth and Godspeed for the leadership of our nation.

<u>Commissioner Shea</u> – gave an update on today's Special Meeting with the economic development consultants where a comprehensive report was given to the Board with key recommendations. Commissioner Shea said there is a lot of material to review and he will be reporting further on the matter. He wished everyone Merry Christmas and best wishes for a great year in 2017.

<u>Commissioner Couch</u> – thanked NCDOT Board Member Malcolm Fearing for the good news regarding the NCDOT Rodanthe Bridge project. He said the bridge will help people have reliable transportation access and expressed hope that it will also provide additional recreational opportunities. While wishing Merry Christmas to the community, Commissioner Couch asked people to remember the reason for the season.

<u>Chairman Woodard</u> – congratulated Malcolm Fearing on receiving the Order of the Long Leaf Pine. He shared a letter from the WW II Coastwise Merchant Mariners, thanking Dare County for its support of veterans. Chairman Woodard commended the Board of Commissioners for their dedication, loyalty, and service to the people of Dare County. He wished everyone Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.

MANAGER'S/ATTORNEY'S BUSINESS

- 1. Mr. Outten said the positive audit report that was presented today makes him proud of the County staff that strives to make the Board's policies come into fruition.
- 2. The Manager raised the issue of a possible boat ramp in Rodanthe. He suggested getting community input by having a Public Hearing with the Wildlife Resources Commission. The Board by consensus instructed the Manager to proceed.
- 3. Mr. Outten reported that community colleges in North Carolina, including COA, received bond money for spending on capital projects. He said COA has an ambitious plan for the Dare County campus and called for a small group of Commissioners to meet with representatives from COA to discuss it. Chairman Woodard said he would talk with the COA Chairman and asked Commissioners to let him know if they want to be part of that effort.
- 4. The Manager explained that grant money may be available to help with the engineering costs for the Hatteras Inlet dredging project. He asked the Board to approve submitting a resolution signed by the Chairman requesting grant funding. MOTION

Vice-Chairman Overman and Commissioner Shea motioned to approve a resolution signed by the Chairman requesting grant funding as outlined by the Manager. Commissioner Couch seconded the motion.

VOTE: AYES unanimous

Public Information Officer Dorothy Hester said she would follow-up with information on the Dare County website to help people submit public comments to oppose the petition for rulemaking that was mentioned by Commissioner House.

At the conclusion of the meeting, Chairman Woodard asked for a motion to adjourn. **MOTION**

Commissioner Shea motioned to adjourn the meeting.

Commissioner Couch seconded the motion.

Chairman Woodard called the special meeting to order at 1:05 p.m. and invited the County's economic development consultants to present their economic diversification plan for Dare County.

Dan Parks, Senior Director of Strategy & Innovation at the NC State University Office of Outreach & Engagement, provided Commissioners with comprehensive information, much of which he said was presented earlier this month at the Community Leader Forum. Mr. Parks explained the methodology that was used in developing a plan that would optimize the County's traditional economic drivers and identify strategies to diversify the local economy. He also outlined a vision and mission statement for economic development capitalizing on the County's unique position as the "Land of Beginnings." Options were presented on how an economic development initiative might be organized and staffed.

Recess - 2:10 pm. - 2:21 pm

Ted Abernathy, Managing Partner at Economic Leadership, LLC discussed how to best implement a new economic development effort in view of global trends that are beyond the control of local leaders. He provided recommendations for the Board to consider including developing a National Sailing Center, linking closely with the UNC Coastal Studies Institute, and positioning The Outer Banks Hospital as a regional hub for providing medical services. Mr. Abernathy stressed that it is important to measure progress when evaluating economic development efforts.

In response to a question from Commissioner Shea about economic development initiatives that have failed, Mr. Parks said failure is due to unrealistic expectations. He added that someone needs to wake up every day thinking that economic development is their priority.

Chairman Woodard thanked the consultants for the vast amount of information that was provided and said the Board will be reviewing the material.

The Special Meeting was adjourned at 3:00 p.m.

Maintenance Contract for Audio Visual System for the RECC/EOC

Description

This item is approval of a 3 year maintenance contract for the audio visual system with the installing contractor at the RECC/EOC Building. The cost is \$21,165 per year after a discount of \$11,205 (15%) for a 3 year contract. The annual cost will be an operating budget cost beginning in FY 2018. The maintenance level is "reactive" for the entire building except for rooms 153 (E911) and rooms 141 (EOC Support Group) and 146 (EOC Support/Control Group) which will have "proactive". Proactive provides nightly system monitoring and video support through a dedicated tablet for each room. A maintenance contract is highly recommended by the contractor and by the architect due to system complexity and that due to the function of the systems (E911 and EOC), they cannot be down.

The North Carolina Department of State Treasurer is providing this letter to Local Government Units to explain new contracting and procurement compliance obligations created by the <u>Iran Divestment Act of 2015</u> (N.C.G.S. 143C-6A-1 to 6A-9).* Local Government Units should be aware that effective February 26, 2016, this law imposes new obligations on each new bid process, each new contract, and each renewal or assignment of an existing contract. The specific requirements are as follows:

- 1. Local Government Units must obtain a one-page mandatory certification under the Act. (See sample "Contract Certification" form below for details.)
- 2. Local Government Units may not enter into contracts with any entity or individual found on the State Treasurer's Iran Final Divestment List. This list will be posted on the Department of State Treasurer's website on February 26, 2016 and will be updated every 180 days. (See "Contract Restrictions" below for details.)

Background

The Iran Divestment Act's requirements applicable to Local Government Units** will become effective on February 26, 2016, at the time the State Treasurer publishes the first list of prohibited companies and individuals (a "Final Divestment List") under the Act.

Final Divestment List

The Department of State Treasurer develops the Final Divestment List using data from a research vendor, U.S. federal sanctions lists, and other credible information available to the public. It consists of any individual or company, including parent entities and majority owned subsidiaries, that:

- Provided goods or services of \$20,000,000 or more within any 12-month period in the energy sector of Iran during the preceding five years;
- Extended \$20,000,000 or more in credit, under certain circumstances, to another individual or company that will use the credit to provide goods or services in the energy sector in Iran. (G.S. 143C-6A-3(4).)

The Department of State Treasurer will update the Final Divestment List at least every 180 days. The list will be published on the State Treasurer's website at www.nctreasurer.com/Iran and periodically circulated to Local Government Units.

Requirement 1: Contract Certification

For new procurements and new, renewed, or assigned contracts on or after February 26, 2016, each Local Government Unit must obtain a simple certification from each bidder or vendor. The bidder or vendor must affirm that it is not listed on the State Treasurer's Final Divestment List found at www.nctreasurer.com/Iran as of the date of signature. The certification is due at the time a bid is submitted or the time a contract is entered into, renewed, or assigned. (G.S. 143C-6A-5(a).)

We have attached on the next page a short form that can be used for this certification, but Local Government Units are free to instead use their own form or put the required certification in the text of a contract or purchase order. Each Local Government Unit shall maintain its own records demonstrating these certifications.

Requirement 2: Restriction on Contracting

Individuals or companies on the Final Divestment List are ineligible to contract or subcontract with Local Government Units. (G.S. 143C-6A-6(a).) Any existing contracts with these Iran-linked persons will be allowed to expire in accordance with the contract's terms. (G.S. 143C-6A-6(c).)

Contracts valued at less than \$1,000.00 are exempt from this restriction. (G.S. 143C-6A-7(a).) In addition, a Local Government Unit may contract with a listed individual or company if it makes a good-faith determination that (1) the commodities or services are necessary to perform its functions and (2) that, absent such an exemption, it would be unable to obtain those commodities or services. (G.S. 143C-6A-7(c).) Local Government Units shall enter such exemptions into the procurement record.

The Act provides that vendors to Local Government Units may not utilize any subcontractor found on the State Treasurer's Final Divestment List. (N.C.G.S. 143C-6A-5(b).) It is each vendor's responsibility to monitor its compliance with this restriction.

Next Steps

The Department of State Treasurer anticipates distributing the first Final Divestment List on February 26, 2016. Once the List has been distributed, all Local Government Units should meet the contract certification requirements.

In July 1997 the Albemarle Commission was restructured with the Board of Directors comprising of one county commissioner from each of the 10 counties and 4 additional delegates. Dare County will have one of the four appointments.

In December 2009 the Albemarle Commission revised their bylaws concerning Board appointments and length of terms. The revision states that a county's elected representative will serve a two year term, beginning January 1st and may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

Based on the Albemarle Commission by-laws, four counties, on a rotating basis, appoint an individual as their at-large member to serve a two year term.

Dare County Community Child Protection Team and Child Fatality Prevention Team

Community Child Protection Teams (CCPT) were established as one means for the state and local communities to form a partnership to strengthen child protection and in response to Executive Order 142 in May 1991. The duties and responsibilities of the CCPT are contained in North Carolina Administrative Code - 10A NCAC 70A .0201. The original purpose and composition of the team were further formalized and expanded by N.C.G.S. §7B-1406, effective July 1, 1993.

In North Carolina, each CCPT reviews active child welfare cases, fatalities, and other cases brought to the team for review. The purpose of the case reviews is to identify systemic deficiencies in child welfare services or resources. Once identified, teams develop strategies to address the gaps in the child welfare system within the county and report to the state areas of concern that warrant action by the state. Teams promote child well-being through collaboration and public awareness.

Child Fatality Prevention Team (CFPT) - The Dare County CCPT has chosen to review the records of all additional child fatalities and report findings in connection with these reviews to the Team Coordinator of the North Carolina Child Fatality Prevention Team (hereafter, CFPT) at the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources in lieu of a separate CPFT.

The team's composition is mandated in NCGS 7B-1406 and includes:

CCPT

- 1. The county director of social services and a member of the director's staff;
- 2. A local law enforcement officer, appointed by the board of county commissioners;
- 3. An attorney from the district attorney's office, appointed by the district attorney;
- 4. The executive director of a local community action agency, as defined by the Division of Economic Opportunity, Department Health and Human Services, or the executive director's designee;
- 5. The superintendent of each local school administrative unit located in the county, or the superintendent's designee;
- 6. A member of the county board of social services, appointed by the chair of that board:
- 7. A local **mental health professional**, appointed by the director of the area authority established under N.C.G.S. §122-C;
- 8. The local guardian ad litem coordinator, or the coordinator's designee;
- 9. The director of the department of public health; and
- 10. A local health care provider, appointed by the local board of public health.

CFPT

- An emergency medical services provider or firefighter, appointed by the board of county Commissioners
- 2. A district court judge, appointed by the chief district court judge in that district
- 3. A county medical examiner, appointed by the Chief Medical Examiner

- 4. A representative of a local child care facility or Head Start Program, appointed by the director of the county DSS
- 5. A parent of a child who died before reaching the child's eighteenth birthday, to be appointed by the board of county commissioners.

The board of commissioners may appoint a maximum of five additional members to represent various county agencies or the community at large.
