There is a \$5 late fee for registering after a program's registration deadline. After paid registration is complete, you will be emailed camp-specific details and/or updates (including attire, shoes, etc.).

FISHING CAMP:



Who: Boys and girls ages 10-14 (Roanoke Island/Mainland residents)

Campers will learn about different types of bait, how to bait a hook and how to tell a fishing story!
