

What do Student Election Assistants do?

Student Assistants do what other poll workers do and get paid the same: \$225 for Election Day. On Election Day, polling places are open from 6:30 AM until 7:30 PM. Training is required and that is compensated as well. Once your application is accepted, you will be given more details, including time and place of training.

Do I Qualify?

In order to serve as a Dare County Student Election Assistant, a student must:

- Be a United States citizen;
- Be at least 17 years old by Election Day;
- Be a resident of the county in which you will serve;
- Be enrolled in a public or private high school or home school;
- Be in good academic standing;
- Have permission from your parent, guardian, or legal custodian;
- Have permission from your school principal or director.

To apply, complete the application and send it to the Dare County Board of Elections at the address on the front panel of this brochure.

Voters and poll personnel must maintain 6' social distance.

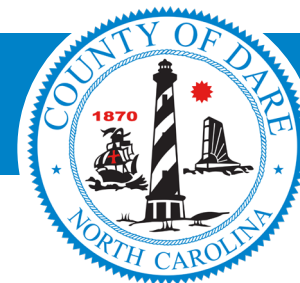
Hands must be sanitized throughout the day.

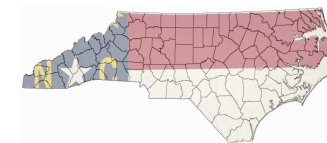
